SPECIAL RULES

- Cooking:** All food must be prepared on site.
- Kids’ Cook-off:** All wagons will be assigned a team of two kids and will prepare peach cobbler (Friday night).
- Food Judging:** The food judging will be conducted in a secured area, isolated from the wagons. The Cook-off Committee will supply the containers for gathering food samples.
- Food Provisions:** The Williamson Museum will furnish meat, beans, fruit, onions, flour, sugar, oil, eggs, and milk, as well as paper goods for serving food. Ice and bottled water will be supplied by WM, with wash water available by hose. Cooks are responsible for their own firewood for cooking on Friday and Saturday. Each wagon must prepare and apportion food for **40** ticket holders.

Potatoes= (no scalloped or potato salad)

DIRECTIONS TO SAN GABRIEL PARK (Two options)

- From I-35, take the Williams Drive exit. Head east on Williams Drive. Turn South on Austin Avenue. Turn East on Morrow Street. Continue on Morrow Street to San Gabriel Park.
- From I-35, take the University Ave/ TX-29 exit. Head east on Hwy 29. Turn north (left) on Austin Avenue. Turn east on Morrow Street. Continue on Morrow Street to San Gabriel Park.

After you pass the football stadium, you will see the Rodeo Arena on the North (left) side of Morrow Street. The green grassy area on the south side of the street is where you check in for the event.
